What is a BarCamp?

- BarCamp
 - international network of user generated conferences—open, participatory workshop-events, whose content is provided by participants—often focusing on early-stage web applications, and related open source technologies, social protocols, and open data formats.
- refers to bar
 - _commonly used logical representation in computer science that is used much like the letters 'x' and 'y' in algebra.
 - _a metasyntactic variable used to represent abstract concepts
 - used to represent any part of a complicated system or idea including data, variables, functions, and commands
 - _commonly used with the metavariables foo to form foobar
- Spin-off of FooCamp, an annual invitation-only participant driven conference hosted by Tim O'Reilly

First BarCamp

- Palo Alto, CA,
 August 19-21, 2005
- organized in less than one week from concept to event
- 200 attendees
- BarCamps have been held in over 31 cities world-wide

BarCamp Rules

- Pre-organized and evangelized through BarCamp wiki
- Sessions proposed and scheduled each day by attendees, mostly on-site
- Venues basic services
 - _typically monetarily free
 - _free network access (usually WiFi)
 - _sponsorship from venue and network access to beverages and food
- All attendees are encouraged to present or facilitate a session
- Share information and experiences of the event, both live and after
- Generally restricted only by space constraints; participants are asked, though, to sign up in advance.



How could MK profit from BarCamps Format?

- 1. Quick response to market dynamics or media coverage
 - Schäuble fingerprint buzz ⇒ BarCamp "Biometry Challenges"
 - Subprime Loan havoc
- ⇒ BarCamp "Reliability of financial Trading Facilities" BarCamp
- **EU Galileo discussions**
- ⇒ BarCamp "The Future of GPS Navigation"
- 2. A practical learning environment for Web 2.0 principles in the "offline world": active engagement, self-organisation, flat management
- 3. Virtual organisational infrastructure can be established with minimal efforts



Challenges of BarCamp to MK

- Will incumbent MK members adapt to the expected profile?
 - Muffathalle instead of ArabellaSheraton
 - _quality of venue, food & beveraged depending on sponsorship
 - _from consumer-oriented to active engagement
- Will MK be able to align existing organisational processes?
 - _pre-organize and organize a BarCamp
 - facilitate a conference day
 - act on the unexpected
- Will MK welcome a new category of conference attendees?
- What will happen to the MK brand?



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
